Message from the Board President

We now start our annual Election process to elect your Board of Directors.

1. Get volunteers to run for District Delegates. This almost never happens so the old ones are kept until they die or move, hopefully in that order. (These Delegates will have the power to elect the Board members)
2. Have election in each district to elect District Delegates. (Sub-Associations do this and advise Master Association of their elected delegate). When no one returns the ballots mailed to them, we pay for a new mailing to get enough people to respond. After the second mailing, we pay for a third mailing and hopefully get enough back to satisfy the legal requirement. I believe after the third mailing the law lets us go on with what we have, but I am not sure.
3. Get volunteers that will serve as Board Members for a two-year period. This is usually very difficult *unless* there are lots of problems that have the members upset. It is, however, VERY important. Without volunteers that keep the Association going, it goes downhill until enough people get upset to get involved and get the Association going in a good direction again.

4. Districts and Sub-Associations then have a vote to identify for whom they want their District Delegates to vote. This step would require the District or Sub-Association to get somewhere around 50% of people in their area to vote. That NEVER happens. If 1% or 2% vote it is a surprise. When 50% of votes aren't cast the District Delegates are free to vote anyway they want.

The District Delegates have a meeting and elect the new board members. That is assuming there are any volunteers that stepped up to run for the board.

With that complete we now have a new Board of Directors to run YOUR Master Association for another year. The term of the board members is 2 years, but we elect 3 members one year and 4 members the next to complete the 7 member Board of Directors. That means we do this process EVERY YEAR.

Please return your ballots when you get them and save us all the cost of multiple mailings. If you ever talk to your neighbors, remind them to do the same, as they surely did not read this and have no clue.

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If you really care *you* could volunteer! Yes *you*! Really! If you don't then some yahoo from down the street will be running *your* Association! We now have a Social Committee to help with the apathy. Perhaps if enough people got to know each other and about the Association we could break the cycle! What do you think?
