Seasonal Checklist

With all the rain we've experienced, it's hard to believe that Spring is just around the corner. Here are some things to consider for your Spring cleaning checklist!

- Remember to trim your trees to ensure that the branches are not hanging over your neighbor's yard or hindering those walking on the sidewalk.
- Removing the entire weed by its root is the surest way of getting rid of it
- Some plants require constant attention, while others are relatively maintenance-free. Check to see the condition of plants during spring.
- Many flowers do better when you "dead-head" them (i.e., pinch off spent blooms), which encourages new growth.
